Animal Industry and Fisheries**MONTHLY COFFEE REPORT-SEPTEMBER 2025****COFFEE YEAR 2024/25- ISSUE 12****Key Highlights**

A total of 844,949 60-kilo bags of coffee valued at US\$ 218.6 million (UGX 766.7 billion) were exported in September 2025 at an average price of US\$ 4.31/kilogram, US cents 36 higher than US\$ 3.95/Kilogram in August 2025, and US cents 23 lower than the US\$ 4.54/kilogram in September 2024. This was an increase of 56.1% and 48.2% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.

Farm-gate prices for Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 6,500/= per kilogram; FAQ UGX **13,500** per kilogram, Arabica parchment UGX **14,500** per kilogram and Drugar UGX **13,500** per kilogram. Mt. Rwenzori C/PB had the highest price registered. (US\$ 9.4 per kilogram)

Coffee exports for twelve months (Coffee Year 2024/ 2025) totaled 8.2 million bags worth US\$ 2.3billion (UGX 8.1 Trillion) compared to 6.4 million bags worth US\$ 1.4 billion (UGX 4.9 trillion) in the previous year (Coffee year 2023/2024). This represents an increase of 29.6% and 64.1% in quantity and value respectively.

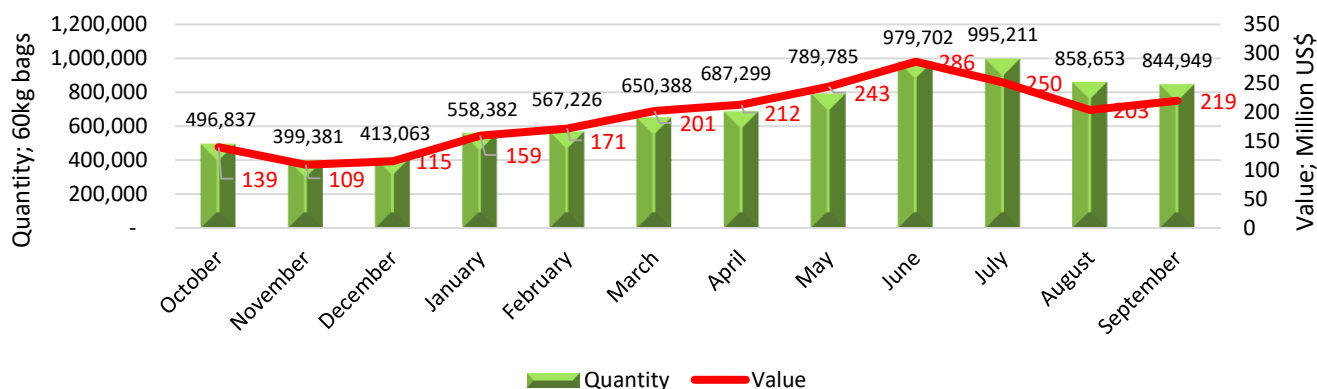
69% of the total export volume was exported by top 10 exporters, out of 78 companies which performed during the month compared to 64% in the month of August 2025. (Annex 2)

1. Coffee exports

Coffee exports in September 2025, totaled to 844,949 bags worth US\$ 218.6 million (UGX 766.7 billion). This comprised of 771,704 bags of Robusta valued at US\$ 190 million (UGX 666.5 billion) and 73,245 bags of Arabica valued at US\$ 28.5 million (UGX 100.1 billion) (see Table 1 and Annex 1). This was an increase of 56.1% and 48.2% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year. Compared to the same month of last year (September 2024), Robusta increased by 50.2% and 35.8% in quantity and value respectively, and Arabica exports increased by 166.2% and 280.2% in quantity and value respectively.

Coffee export volume was higher than the previous year on account of increased coffee production as harvest in Central and Eastern regions is already underway. Coffee prices at the global scene improved as concerns regarding supply of coffee into the USA, due to uncertainty of the proposed 50% tariffs on goods entering the country from Brazil saw stocks starting to deplete.

2. Exports by Type and Grade

Table 2 shows coffee exports by type, grade and average price realized for each grade during the month of September 2025. The average export price was US\$ 4.31 per kilogram, US cents 36 higher than in August 2025 (US\$ 3.95). It was US cents 23 lower than in September 2024 (US \$ 4.54/kilogram). Robusta exports accounted for 91% of total exports, lower than 93% in August 2025. The average Robusta price was US\$ 4.10 per kilogram, 32 cents higher than US\$ 3.78 per kilo the previous month. The highest price was for Screen 17 Robusta sold at US\$ 4.62 per kilogram, followed by Screen 14 sold at US\$ 4.22 per kilogram.

The share of Sustainable/washed coffee to total Robusta exports was 0.33% slightly higher than 0.30% in July2025. Arabica fetched an average price of US\$ 6.50 per kilogram US cents 20 higher than the previous month (US\$ 6.30). The highest price was for Rwenzori C/PB sold at US\$ 9.83 per kilogram. It was followed by Bugisu AB sold at US\$ 7.93 per kilogram. Drugar was sold at US\$ 6.34 per kilogram, 14 cents lower than US \$ 6.48 per kilogram the previous month. Drugar exports were 52% of total Arabica exports lower than 47% the previous month. The share of sustainable Arabica exports to total Arabica exports was 7%, lower than 14% in August 2025.

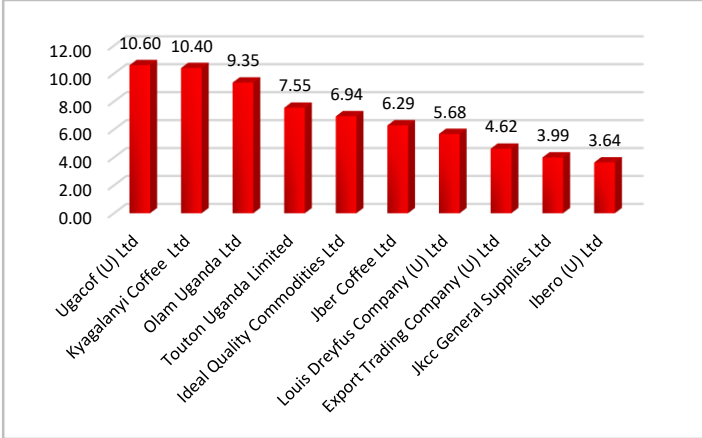

3. Individual Exporter Performance

Figure 2 shows the top 10 export companies' performance in the month of September 2025. Ugacof (U) Ltd had the highest market share of 10.60% compared to 7.13% in August 2025. It was followed by . Kyagalanyi Coffee Ltd 10.40% (8.73%), Olam Uganda Ltd 9.35% (8.26%), Touton Uganda Limited 7.55% (2.94%) Ideal quality Co m m o d i t i e s Ltd 6.94 % (7.48%), Jber Coffee Ltd 6.29 % (7.63%), Louis Dreyfus Company (U)Ltd 5.68% (2.70%), Export Trading Company (U)Ltd 4.62% (8.61%) JKCC General Supplies Ltd 3.99% (4.00%) and Ibero (U) Ltd 3.64% (4.78%) *The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in August 2025. The top 10 exporters held a market share of 69% higher than 64% the previous month reflecting competition at exporter level. Out of the 78 exporters who exported, 48 exported Robusta Coffee only while 11 exported Arabica coffee only. Annex 2 shows a detailed list of exporters' performance in September 2025

4. Coffee ExportsBy Destination

The destinations of Uganda's coffee exports during the month of September 2025 are shown in **Fig 3** (details in **Annex 3**). Italy maintained the highest market share with 25.63% compared to 29.27% last month. It was followed by Germany 13.04% (10.02%), Morocco 7.52% (3.93%), Sudan 6.79% (13.13%), and Algeria 5.95% (5.38%). **The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in August 2025.* The first 10 major destinations of Uganda coffee took a market share of 77.90% compared to 79.59% the previous month. Coffee exports to African countries totaled 182,441 bags, a market share of 22% compared to 195,858 bags (23%) the previous month. African countries that imported Uganda coffee included Morocco Sudan, Algeria, Egypt, Tunisia, South Africa, Kenya, Senegal and Nigeria. Europe remained the main destination for Uganda's coffees with a 61% import share, higher than 62% in August 2025.

5. Foreign buyers of Uganda Coffee

Annex 4 shows a list of Uganda coffee foreign buyers in September 2025. The top 10 buyers held a market share of 54.25% lower than 43.81% the previous month. Sucafina led with a market share of 11.43% compared to 7.01% in August 2025. It was followed by Olam International with 10.32% (8.76%); Touton SA 7.88% (3.29%); Louis Dreyfus 6.361% (3.64%); Ecom Agro Industrialist 4.14% (3.00%) Bernhard Rothfos 3.77% (6.02%); Volcafe 3.53% (3.81%) GRB 2.64% (31.24%), Koninklijke Douwe Egberts 2.64% (3.75%) and Strauss 1.53% (1.66%); *The figures in brackets represent percentage marketshare held in August 2025*

Figure 3: Top ten export destinations by percentage market share

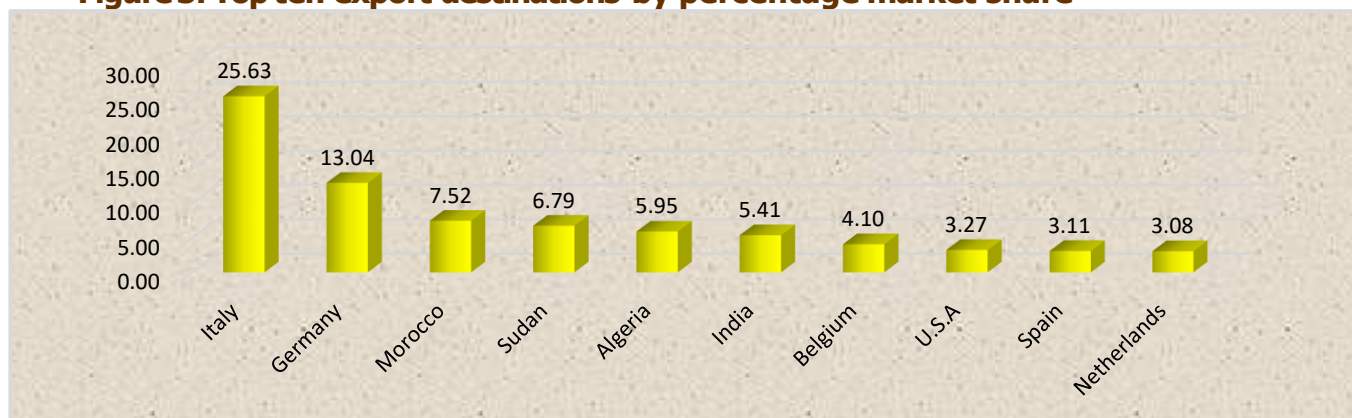


Figure 4: Percentage share of Uganda's coffee imported by continent

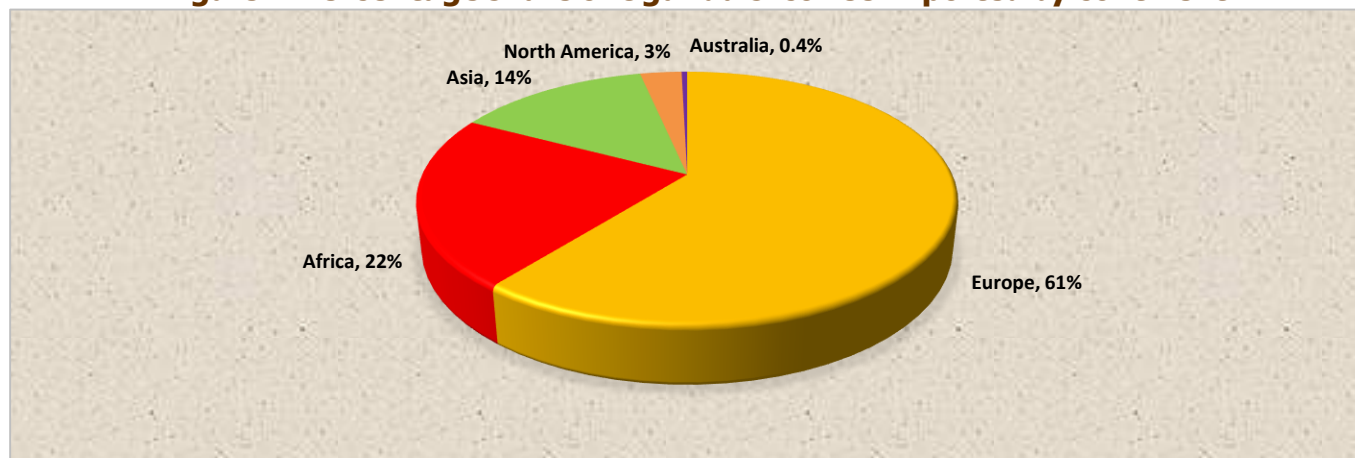
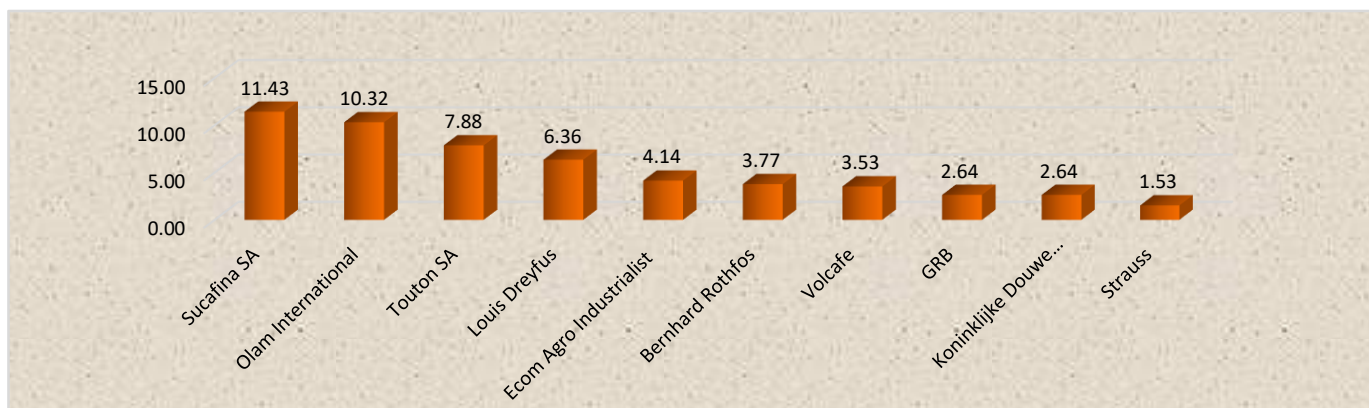


Figure 5: Top ten buyers by percentage market share



6. Global Situation

World coffee production for 2025/26 is forecast to be 4.3 million bags higher than the previous year to a record 178.7 million due to continued recovery in Vietnam and Indonesia as well as record output in Ethiopia. World coffee bean exports are forecast 700,000 bags higher to 122.3 million as gains from Vietnam, Ethiopia, and Indonesia more than offset losses from Brazil and Colombia. Global consumption is forecast at 169.4 million bags, while ending inventories are expected to remain tight at 22.8 million bag. (United States Department of Agriculture, Coffee: World Markets and Trade report-June 2025).

7. Local Situation

During the month of September 2025, farm gate prices ranged from UGX 6,000-7,000 per kilogram of Kiboko (Robusta dry cherries); UGX.13,500-14,000 for FAQ (Fair Average Quality); UGX 14,000-15,000 for Arabica Parchment; and UGX 13,500-14,000 per kilogram for Drugar. Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 6,500 higher than UGX 5,250 Robusta FAQ averaged UGX 13,750 higher than UGX 10,250, Arabica parchment UGX 14,500 per kilogram, higher than UGX 13,75 per kilogram the previous month Drugar UGX 13,750 per kilogram lower than UGX 12,500 per kilogram the previous month.

8. Coffee Consumption and Promotional Activities

Uganda, represented by the Embassy of Uganda in Tokyo and the Ministry of Agriculture, Animal Industry and Fisheries (MAAIF) showcased its specialty Arabica and fine Robusta coffees at the Specialty Coffee Expo Japan 2025, held from September 24–27, 2025. The Ugandan delegation included leading private exporters such as Mountain Harvest, Bugisu Cooperative Union, JKCC, Crystal Coffee, and Gorilla Highland Coffee Company. The country's presence was marked by a well-branded exhibition booth featuring brew bars and business-to-business (B2B) meetings. A seminar on Investment Opportunities in Uganda's Coffee Sector was also held during the Expo. These activities attracted significant interest, particularly in Uganda's washed and natural Arabicas, as well as washed Robustas. There was high booth traffic and strong engagement during coffee tasting sessions and positive feedback during cupping at the Uganda Coffee seminar was received. Japan continues to be a strategic market for Uganda's coffee exports as exhibited in the increasing coffee exports to the country.

9. Coffee Development Activities

In line with the ongoing strategy to enhance coffee production, productivity, and market competitiveness, a series of targeted interventions were implemented across Uganda's major coffee-growing regions during September 2025.

A total of 4,343 farmers benefited from 166 specialized training sessions focused on Pest and disease management, Soil fertility and conservation, Coffee establishment and rehabilitation, post-harvest handling, Climate-smart agriculture, Cooperative formation and Coffee farming as a business

Additionally, five sensitization sessions were conducted, reaching 701 farmers, with a focus on the EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR), farmer registration, and value chain actor registration.

To reinforce adoption of Good Agronomic Practices (GAPs) and provide hands-on technical support, 235 farm visits were carried out, directly reaching 1,170 farmers. These visits also facilitated pest and disease surveillance and supported on-site implementation of recommended practices.

A total of 190 coffee nurseries, were verified for compliance with established quality standards. To improve coffee quality along the value chain, 29 sensitization meetings were held, focusing on post-harvest handling, hygiene, and compliance with the Coffee Act 2025 (amended). These sessions engaged 436 participants (320 male, 116 female) across all 11 regions. As part of regulatory monitoring, 241 value chain actors were inspected, including 140 coffee factories and 101 stores

Following these inspections, 149 operators were registered for licensing in compliance with sector regulations.

10. Outlook for October 2025

Uganda's Coffee exports are projected to reach 850,000 60-kilo bags in October 2025. The main harvest season in some parts of Central and Eastern Regions has begun.
