

MONTHLY COFFEE REPORT-APRIL 2025

COFFEE YEAR 2024/25- ISSUE 7

Key Highlights



A total of 694,318 60-kilo bags of coffee valued at US\$ 214.38 million were exported in April 2025 at an average price of US\$ 5.15/kilo, US cent 1 higher than US\$ 5.14/Kilo in March 2025, and US\$ 1.53 higher than US\$ 3.62/kilo in April 2024. This was an increase of 77.44% and 152.56% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.



Farm-gate prices for Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX **7,200** per kilo; FAQ UGX **14,500** per kilo, Arabica parchment UGX **14,800** per kilo and Drugar UGX **14,000** per kilo.



Coffee exports for twelve months (May 2024-April 2025) totaled 7.17 million bags worth US\$ 1.97 billion compared to 5.90 million bags worth US\$ 1.01 billion in the previous year (May 2023-April 2024). This represents an increase of 21.70% and 94.64% in quantity and value respectively.



68.43% of the total volume was exported by top 10 exporters, out of 75 companies which performed during the month compared to 68% in March 2025.

Sustainable Arabica had the highest price at US \$ 8.70 per kilo.

1. Coffee exports

Coffee exports in April 2025, amounted to 694,318 60-kilo bags valued at US\$ 214.38 million. This comprised of 594,188 bags of Robusta valued at US\$ 177.08 million and 100,130 bags of Arabica valued at US\$ 37.30 million (see Table 1 and Annex 1). This was an increase of 77.44% and 152.56% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.

By comparing quantity of coffee exported by type in the same month of last year (April 2024), Robusta increased by 104.63% and 187.61% in quantity and value respectively, while Arabica exports decreased by 0.8% in quantity but increased by 60% in value.

The monthly coffee exports volume was higher than the previous year on account of good crop from the main harvest in Masaka and south Western regions. The value of coffee exports was higher due to the high global coffee prices as dry conditions in Brazil and Vietnam, the world's largest producers of Arabica and Robusta coffee respectively continue to fuel uncertainty of the global coffee supply.

Coffee exports for twelve months (May 2024-April 2025) totaled 7.17 million bags worth US\$ 1.97 billion compared to 5.90 million bags worth US\$ 1.01 billion in the previous year (May 2023-April 2024). This represents an increase of 21.70% and 94.64% in quantity and value respectively.

Fig 1: Trend of Total Quantity and Value of Coffee Exports, May 2024- April 2025

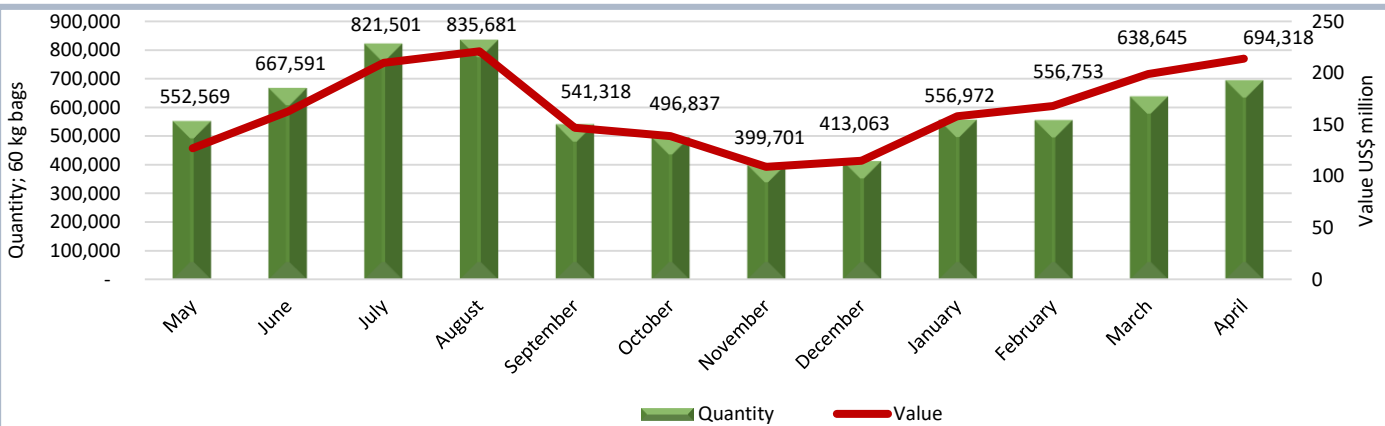

2. Exports by Type and Grade

Table 2 shows coffee export by type, grade and average realized price for each grade during the month of April 2025. The average export price was US\$ 5.15 per kilo, US cents 1 higher than in March 2025 (US\$ 5.14). It was US\$ 1.53 higher than in April 2024 (US \$ 3.62/kilo). Robusta exports accounted for 86% of total exports, higher than 82% in February 2025. The average Robusta price was US\$ 4.97 per kilo, 5 cents higher than US\$ 4.92 per kilo the previous month. The highest price was for Screen 18 sold at US\$ 5.33 per kilo, followed by Washed Robusta sold at US\$ 5.31 per kilo.

The share of Sustainable/washed coffee to total Robusta exports was 0.32% lower than 0.38% in March 2025.

Arabica fetched an average price of US\$ 6.21 per kilo US cents 12 higher than the previous month (US\$ 6.09). The highest price was for Sustainable Arabica sold at US\$ 8.70 per kilo. It was followed by Bugisu C sold at US\$ 7.81 per kilo. Drugar was sold at US\$ 6.54 per kilo, 13 cents lower than 6.67 per kilo the previous month. Drugar exports were 55% of total Arabica exports higher than 39% the previous month. The share of sustainable Arabica exports to total Arabica exports was 4%, lower than 10% in March 2025.

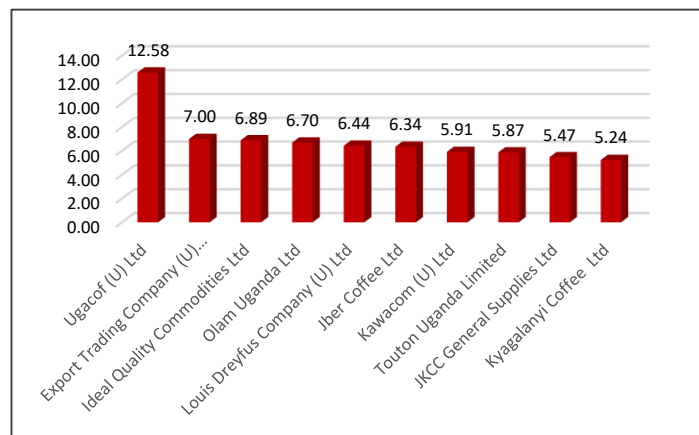

3. Individual Exporter Performance

Figure 2 shows the top 10 export companies' performance in the month of April 2025. Ugacof (U) Ltd had the highest market share of 12.58% compared to 12.35% in March 2025. It was followed by Export Trading Company (U) Ltd 7% (6.86%), Ideal Quality Commodities Ltd 6.89% (7.43%) Olam Uganda Ltd 6.7% (7.67%) Louis Dreyfus (U) Ltd 6.44%(6.15%), Jber Coffee Ltd 6.34% (6.08%), Kawacom (U) Ltd 5.91% (5.11%), Touton 5.87%(3.15%), JKCC 5.47%(6.4%) and Kyagalanyi Coffee Ltd 5.24% (5.90%) **The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in March 2025.*

The top 10 exporters held a market share of 68.43% slightly higher than 68% the previous month reflecting competition at exporter level. Out of the 80 exporters who performed, 32 exported Robusta Coffee only while 12 exported Arabica coffee only. **Annex 2** shows a detailed list of exporters' performance in April 2025.

4. Coffee Exports By Destination

The destinations of Uganda's coffee exports during the month of April 2025 are shown in **Fig 3** (details in **Annex 3**). Italy maintained the highest market share with 42.02% compared to 38.43% last month. It was followed by Germany 11.30%(6.89%), Spain 7.46% (6.06%), India 6.79% (8.92%), and Sudan 4.72% (5.72%). **The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in March 2025.* The first 10 major destinations of Uganda coffee took a market share of 87.26% compared to 85.06% the previous month. Coffee exports to African countries totaled 76,467 bags, a market share of 11% compared to 69,052 bags (11%) the previous month. African countries that imported Uganda coffee included Sudan, Algeria, Morocco, Egypt, Tunisia, Kenya, Tanzania, and South Africa. Europe remained the main destination for Uganda's coffees with a 71% import share, lower than 63% in March 2025.

5. Foreign buyers of Uganda Coffee

Annex 4 shows a list of Uganda coffee foreign buyers in April 2025. The top 10 buyers held a market share of 55.48% higher than 52.64% the previous month. Sucafina led with a market share of 12.67% compared to 12.4% in March 2025. It was followed by Louis Dreyfus 8.61% (8.98%); Olam International 7.13% (8.78%); Ecom Agro Industrialist 6.44% (5.25%);Touton SA 6.11% (3.1%) Bernhard Rothfos 4.29% (4.64%); Pacorini Silocaf 3.33% (3.36%) Export Commodities 2.54%(1.2%)Koninklijke Douwe 2.39% (2.07%) CCL Products1.97% (3.34%); *The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in March 2025*

Figure 4: Percentage share of Uganda's coffee export destinations by continent

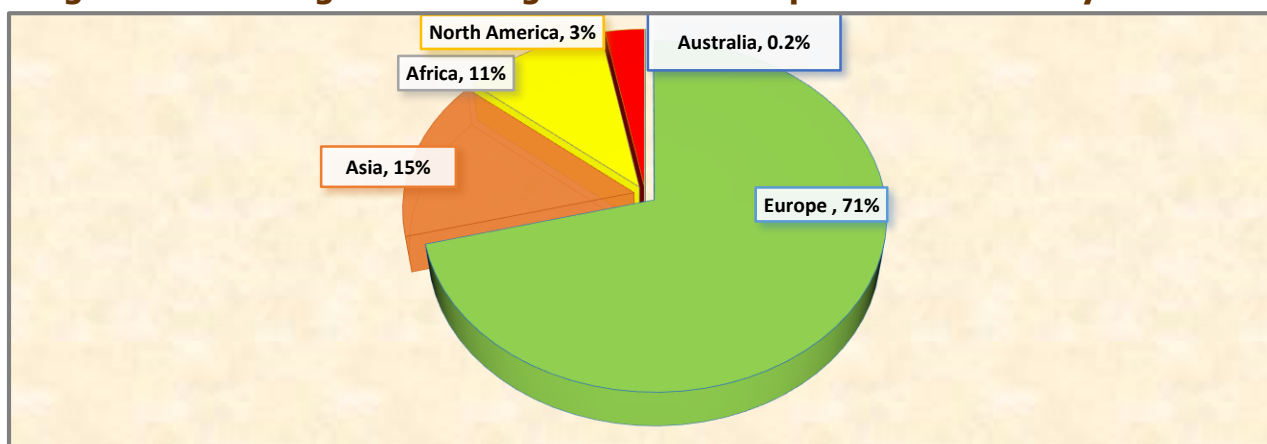
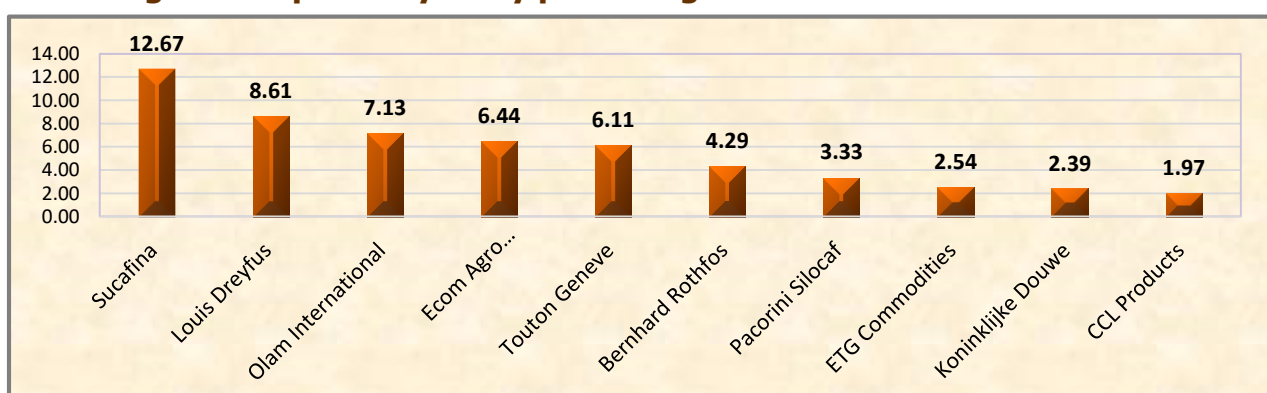


Figure 5: Top ten buyers by percentage market share



6. Global Situation

World coffee production for 2024/25 is forecast to reach 6.9 million bags higher than the previous year to 174.9 million due primarily to rebounding output in Vietnam and Indonesia. World exports are forecast to be slightly higher as gains in Vietnam and Indonesia more than offset reduced shipments from Brazil. Global consumption is expected to increase by 5.1 million bags to 168.1 million, with the largest gains in the European Union, the United States, and China. Ending stocks are expected to drop by 1.5 million bags to 20.9 million. (United States Department of Agriculture, Coffee: World Markets and Trade report-December 2024).

8.Coffee Consumption and Promotional Activities.

Uganda, represented by the Uganda Embassy in Ankara and the Ministry of Agriculture Animal Industry and Fisheries' Department of Coffee, showcased its specialty Arabica and fine Robusta coffees at the Coffex Expo in Istanbul from May 9th – 11th 2025. Through a well branded booth featuring a brew bar, cupping sessions, and B2B meetings, the delegation attracted strong interest particularly in Uganda's washed Arabicas and Robustas.

Key highlights included high booth traffic during iced coffee tastings, positive buyer feedback during cupping sessions, and new trade leads from business engagements. A networking "Happy Hour" further promoted Ugandan coffee culture, while international media coverage increased global visibility.

A notable outcome was the establishment of a Ugandan coffee warehouse in Turkey, improving market access. Recommendations include developing a strong national coffee brand, enhancing marketing efforts, and continuing diplomatic-private sector collaboration to grow Uganda's share in the USD 317M Turkish coffee market whose growth rate is estimated at 54% by 2030.

7. Local Situation

During the month of April 2025, farm gate prices ranged from UGX 7,000/=7,400/= per kilo of Kiboko (Robusta dry cherries); UGX.14,500/=15,000/= for FAQ (Fair Average Quality); UGX. 14,500- 15,000/= for Arabica Parchment; and UGX 14,000/=14,500/= per kilo for Drugar. Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 7,200/= lower than UGX 7,600/= Robusta FAQ averaged UGX 14,500/= lower than UGX 15,250, Arabica parchment UGX 14,800 per kilo, lower than 15,000/= Drugar UGX 14,000/= per kilo lower than 14,500/= per kilo

9. Coffee Development Activities

During April 2025, all coffee-growing regions experienced varied patterns across regions conditions, with a mix of above average, normal, and localized below-average precipitation. These weather conditions broadly supported key coffee agronomic activities, including planting, pruning, ripening, and post-harvest.

processing. The Black Coffee Twig Borer and Red Blister Disease remained the most severe challenge in Central, Eastern, Greater Mpigi, Rwenzori and Mid North. Coffee Leaf Rust was observed in Arabica coffee-growing districts of Elgon and West Nile. The Regional Agricultural Officers conducted visits to 752 farms (610 male-owned, 141 female-owned and 64 youth owned) to provide guidance on disease management, farm rehabilitation and stamping and disease servillience. A total of 64 coffee-specific training in Good Agronomical Practices (GAPs) were undertaking across all regions, benefiting 1,872 farmers, including 1,446 men, 326 women, 248 youths, 31 People With Disabilities and 31 elderly.

Across the regions, inspections were conducted to ensure compliance with post-harvest handling and processing standards. While structural compliance is improving, especially in Busoga.

10. Outlook for May 2025

Coffee exports are projected to be 680,000 60-kilobags. The main harvest season in Greater Masaka and south west is underway the fly crop north of equator has begun.
