


MONTHLY COFFEE REPORT-JULY 2025 **Key Highlights**

A total of 997,105 60-kilo bags of coffee valued at US\$ 289.60 million (UGX 898.80 billion) were exported in July 2025 at an average price of US\$ 4.19/kilogram, US cents 57 lower than US\$ 4.76/Kilogram in June 2025, and US cents 8 lower than US\$ 4.27/kilogram in July 2024. This was an increase of 21.38% and 19.08% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.





Coffee exports for twelve months (August 2024-July 2025) totaled 7.93 million bags worth US\$ 2.25 billion (UGX 8.07 Trillion) compared to 6.88 million bags worth US\$ 6.88 1.41 billion (UGX 5.06 trillion) in the previous year (August 2023-July 2024). This represents an increase of 15.29% and 59.42% in quantity and value respectively.



65% of the export total volume was exported by top 10 out of 91 companies which performed during the month compared to 68% in the month of June 2025.

Wugar had the highest price at US\$ 7.20 per kilogram

Coffee exports for the first ten month of coffee year 2024/25 (October 2024-July 2025) were 6.55 million bags worth US\$ 1.88 billion compared to 4.98 million bags worth US\$ 1.03 billion in the same period the previous year (October 2023-July 2024).

1. Coffee exports

Coffee exports in July 2025, amounted to 997,105 bags worth US\$ 250.60 million (UGX 898.80 billion).This comprised of 914,448 bags of Robusta valued at US\$ 220.54 million (UGX 790.98 billion) and 82,105 bags of Arabica valued at US\$ 30.06 million (UGX 107.83 billion) (see Table 1 and Annex 1). This was an increase of 21.38% and 19.08% in quantity and value respectively compared to same month last year. Compared to the same month of last year (July 2024), Robusta increased by 18.40% and 11.40% in quantity and value respectively, while Arabica exports increased by 68.18% and 140.87% in quantity and value respectively. 11.40%

Coffee export volume was higher than the previous year on account of a good crop harvest in most coffee growing especially Greater Masaka and South Western Regions. Export value of coffee was also higher due to the higher volumes. The average price was however lower than last year as global prices decreased due to signs of increased supply from Vietnam and new harvest from Brazil.

Coffee exports for twelve months (August 2024-July 2025) totaled 7.93 million bags worth US\$ 2.25 billion compared million bags worth US\$ 1.41 billion in the previous year (August 2023-July 2024). This represents an increase of 15.29% and 59.42% in quantity and value respectively.

Fig 1: Trend of Total Quantity and Value of Coffee Exports, August 2024- July 2025



2. Exports by Type and Grade

Table 2 shows coffee exports by type, grade and average price realized for each grade during the month of July 2025. The average export price was US\$ 4.19 per kilogram, US cents 57 lower than in May 2025 (US\$ 5.76). It was US cents 8 higher than in July 2024 (US \$ 4.27/kilogram). Robusta exports accounted for 92% of total exports, higher than 89% in June 2025. The average Robusta price was US\$ 4.02 per kilogram, 55 cents lower than US\$ 4.57 per kilo the previous month. The highest price was for Organic Robusta sold at US\$ 4.73 per kilogram, followed by Screen 17 sold at US\$ 4.28 per kilogram.

The share of Sustainable/washed coffee to total Robusta exports was 0.51% slightly higher than 0.22% in June2025.

Arabica fetched an average price of US\$ 6.06 per kilogram US cents 33 lower than the previous month (US\$ 6.39). The highest price was for Wugar sold at US\$ 7.20 per kilogram. It was followed by Mt. Elgon A+ sold at US\$ 7.11 per kilogram. Drugar was sold at US\$ 6.34 per kilogram, 1 cent I o w er than U S \$ 6.35 per kilogram the previous month. Drugar exports were 54% of total Arabica exports lower that 63% the previous month. The share of sustainable Arabica exports to total Arabica exports was 5 %, higher than 2% in June 2025.



3. Individual Exporter Performance

Figure 2 shows the top 10 export companies' performance in the month of J u ly 2025. Ugacof (U) Ltd had the highest market share of 11.87% compared to 12.18% in J u n e 2025. It was followed by Export Trading Company (U) Ltd 8.37% (10.17%), Jber Coffee Ltd 7.03% (5.98%), Kyagalanyi Coffee Ltd 6.93% (5.17%) I de al Q u ality Commodities Ltd 6.82% (6.08%), Touton Uganda Limited 5.55% (7.06%), Olam Uganda Limited 5.48% (8.02%), Louis Dreyfus Company (U) Ltd 4.89% (4.47%) Ibero (U) Ltd 4.82% (2.93%), a n d Kawacom (U) Ltd 3.53% (2.71%) *The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in June 2025. 6.82%

The top 10 exporters held a market share of 65% I o w e r than 68% the previous month reflecting competition at exporter level. Out of the 91 exporters who exported, 59 exported Robusta Coffee only while 11 exported Arabica coffee only. Annex 2 shows a detailed list of exporters' performance in July 2025.

4. Coffee Exports By Destination


Figure 3: Top ten export destinations by percentage market share

The destinations of Uganda's coffee exports during the month of July 2025 are shown in Fig 3 (details in Annex 3). Italy maintained the highest market share with 31.14% compared to 34.67% last month. It was followed by Sudan 12.51% (7.80%), Germany 11.40% (12.22%), Algeria 6.15% (4.25%), and Belgium 4.16% (2.34%). *The f igures in brackets represent percentage market share held in June 2025. The first 10 major destinations of Uganda coffee took a market share of 79.88% compared to 79.19% the previous month. Coffee exports to African countries totaled 236,691 bags, a market share of 24% compared to 169,663 bags (16%) the previous month. African countries that imported Uganda included Sudan, Algeria, Morocco, Egypt, Tunisia, South Africa, Libya Tanzania, Kenya, Somalia, and Senegal. Europe remained the main destination for Uganda's coffees with a 61% import share, lower than 68% in June 2025.

5. Foreign buyers of Uganda Coffee

Annex 4 shows a list of Uganda coffee foreign buyers in July 2025. The top 10 buyers held a market share of 51.27% lower than 55.19% the previous month. Sucafina led with a market share of 11.64% compared to 12.16% in June 2025. It was followed by Olam International 6.48 % (9.25%); Louis Dreyfus 6.06% (5.01%); Bernhard Rothfos 5.68% (3.92%); Touton SA 5.54% (8.04%) Ecom Agro Indusrialst 3.79% (3.97%); Koninklijke Douwe Egberts B.V 3.50% (5.75%) ETG Commodities B.V 2.88% (3.40%), Volcafe Ltd 2.85% (1.65%) and Almagsora International 2.84% (1.10%); The figures in brackets represent percentage marketshare held in June 2025 5.68%

6. Global Situation

World coffee production for 2025/26 is forecast to be 4.3 million bags higher than the previous year to a record 178.7 million due to continued recovery in Vietnam and Indonesia as well as record output in Ethiopia. World coffee bean exports are forecast 700,000 bags higher to 122.3 million as gains from Vietnam, Ethiopia, and Indonesia more than offset losses from Brazil and Colombia. Global consumption is forecast at 169.4 million bags, while ending inventories are expected to remain tight at 22.8 million bag. (United States Department of Agriculture, Coffee: World Markets and Trade report-June 2025).

7. Local Situation

During the month of July 2025, farm gate prices ranged from UGX 5,000/=-5,500/= per kilogram of Kiboko (Robusta dry cherries); UGX.10,000/=-10,500/= for FAQ (Fair Average Quality); UGX. 13,500- 14,000/= for Arabica Parchment; and UGX 12,000/=- 13,000/= per kilogram for Drugar. Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 5,250/= lower than UGX 5,750/= Robusta FAQ averaged UGX 10,250/= lower than UGX 11,500, Arabica parchment UGX 13,750 per kilogram, I o w e r t h a n U G X 1 4,000/= per kilogram the previous month Drugar UGX 12,500/= per kilogram lower than UGX 13,500 per kilogram the previous month

8. Coffee Development Activities

In July 2025, a range of strategic interventions were implemented to boost coffee production, improve productivity and enhance market access and competitiveness of Uganda's coffee in both domestic and international markets. A total of 3,816 farmers across all major coffee-growing regions benefited from 110 specialized training sessions. These sessions focused on key areas including: pest and disease management, soil fertility and conservation, coffee establishment and rehabilitation, post-harvest handling, climate-smart agriculture, cooperative formation, and coffee farming as a business.

As part of the extension support, 309 farm visits were conducted, reaching 1,564 farmers with practical, on-site technical guidance. These visits also support disease surveillance and the implementation of Good Agronomic Practices (GAPs).

In an effort to promote coffee growing in non-traditional regions, a total of 2,283,726 seedlings were distributed to 1,396 farmers in Mid North and West Nile regions.

To support quality enhancement along the coffee value chain, two sensitization workshops were conducted on post-harvest handling practices, targeting improved coffee quality. These workshops engaged 72 participants in Northern and South West regions. Additionally, two regional mini taskforces were deployed in the South West and Northern regions to strengthen compliance and quality assurance. As part of regulatory enforcement and monitoring, 405 value chain actors were inspected, including 174 coffee factories, 167 stores, 58 wet mills, 1 grading unit, and 5 roasteries. From these inspections, 226 operators were registered for licensing, comprising: 82 hullers, 54 buyers, 79 store operators and 11 roasters.

9. Outlook for August 2025

Uganda's Coffee exports are projected to reach 700,000 60-kilo bags in August 2025. The main harvest season in Greater Masaka and south west and the fly crop North of equator has ended. However farmers and traders are still having stocks that were withheld as they waited for improvement in the coffee prices.
