

MONTHLY COFFEE REPORT-AUGUST 2025

Key Highlights



Farm-gate prices for Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 6,500/= per kilogram; FAQ UGX **13,500** per kilogram, Arabica parchment UGX **14,500** per kilogram and Drugar UGX **13,500** per kilogram.



Coffee exports for twelve months (September 2024-August 2025) totaled 7.9 million bags worth US\$ 2.2 billion (UGX 7.9 Trillion) compared to 6.7 million bags worth US\$ 1.4 billion (UGX 5 trillion) in the previous year (September 2023-August 2024). This represents an increase of 17.9% and 58.7% in quantity and value respectively.



64% of the export total volume was exported by top 10 exporters, out of 8 2 companies which performed during the month compared to 65% in the month of July 2025. (Annex 2)

Mt. Elgon A+ had the highest price at US\$ 9.4 per kilogram. Coffee exports for eleven month of coffee year 2024/25 (October 2024-August 2025) were 7.4 million bags worth US\$ 2.1 billion compared to 5.8 million bags worth US\$ 1.3 billion in the same period the previous year (October 2023-August 2024).

Coffee export volume was slightly higher than the previous year on account of a good crop harvest in most coffee growing regions. Export value of coffee was however lower than the same moth last year and was seen in Robusta as a result of the spill over effect from July when prices went down.

Coffee exports for twelve months (September 2024-August 2025) totaled 7.9 million bags worth US\$ 2.2 billion (UGX 7.9 Trillion) compared to 6.7 million bags worth US\$ 1.4 billion (UGX 5 trillion) in the previous year (September 2023-August 2024). 1. Coffee exports

Coffee exports in August 2025, amounted to 855,441 bags worth US\$ 202.75 million (UGX 722.58 billion).This comprised of 797,363 bags of Robusta valued at US\$ 180.8 million (UGX 644.3 billion) and 58,078 bags of Arabica valued at US\$ 22.00 million (UGX 78.3 billion) (see Table 1 and Annex 1). This was an increase of 2.5% in quantity and a decrease of 8.2% in value compared to the same month last year. Compared to the same month of last year (August 2024), Robusta increased by 1.8% in quantity and decreased by 12.9% in value. Arabica exports increased by 11.9% %and 64% in quantity and value respectively.

2. Exports by Type and Grade

Table 2 shows coffee exports by type, grade and average price realized for each grade during the month of August 2025. The average export price was US\$ 3.95 per kilogram, US cents 24 lower than in July 2025 (US\$ 4.19). It was US cents 8 higher than in July 2024 (US\$ 4.27/kilogram). Robusta exports accounted for 93% of total exports, higher than 92% in July 2025. The average Robusta price was US\$ 3.78 per kilogram, 24 cents lower than US\$ 4.02 per kilo the previous month. The highest price was for Washed Robusta sold at US\$ 3.78 per kilogram, followed by Screen 12 sold at US\$ 3.95 per kilogram.

exports was 0.30% slightly lower than 0.51% in July2025.

Arabica fetched an average price of US\$ 6.30 per kilogram US cents 2 4 higher than the previous month (US\$ 6.06). The

cents 2 4 higher than the previous month (US\$ 6.06). The highest price was for Mt. Elgon A+ sold at US\$ 9.42 per kilogram. It was followed by Mt. Elgon B sold at US\$ 8.82 per kilogram. Drugar was sold at US\$ 6.48 per kilogram, 1 4 cents higher than U S \$ 6.34 per kilogram the previous month. Drugar exports were 47% of total Arabica exports lower that 54% the previous month. The share of sustainable Arabica exports to total Arabica exports was 14%, higher than 5% in July 2025.

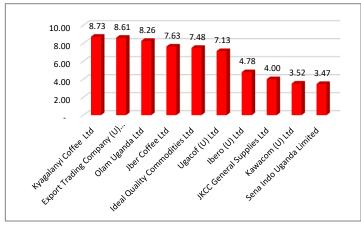

3. Individual Exporter Performance

Figure 2 shows the top 10 export companies' performance in the month of August 2025. Kyagalanyi Coffee Ltd had the highest market share of 8.73% compared to 6.93% in July 2025. It was followed by Export Trading Company (U) Ltd 8.61% (8.37%), Olam Uganda Ltd 8.26% (5.48%), Jber Coffee Ltd 7.63% (7.03%) Ideal Quality Commodities Ltd 7.48% (6.82%), Ugacof (U) Ltd 7.13% (11.87%), Ibero (U) Ltd 4.78% (4.82%), JKCC General Supplies Ltd 4.00% (3.17%) Kawacom (U) Ltd 3.52% (3.53%), and Sena Indo Uganda Limited 3.47% (2.06%) *The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in July 2025. The top 10 exporters held a market share of 64% I o w e r than 65% the previous month reflecting competition at exporter 82 exporters who level. 4. Coffee Exports By Destination

The destinations of Uganda's coffee exports during the month of August 2025 are shown in Fig 3 (details in Annex 3). Italy maintained the highest market share with 29.27% compared last month. It was followed by Sudan 13.13% (12.51%), Germany 10.02% (11.40%), Algeria 5.38% (6.15%), and India 4.49% (3.04%). *The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in July 2025. The first 10 major destinations of Uganda coffee took a market share of 79.59% compared to 79.88% the previous month. Coffee exports to African countries totaled 195,858 bags, a market share of 23% compared to 236,691 bags (24%) the previous month. African countries that imported Uganda coffee included Algeria, Morocco, Egypt, South Africa, Tunisia, and Kenya. Europe remained the destination for Uganda's coffees with a 62% import share, higher than 61% in July 2025.

5. Foreign buyers of Uganda Coffee

Annex 4 shows a list of Uganda coffee foreign buyers in August 2025. The top 10 buyers held a market share of 43.81% lower than 51.27% the previous month. Olam International led with a market share of 8.76% compared to 6.48% in July 2025. It was followed by Sucafina with 7.10% (11.64%); Bernhard Rothfos 6.02% (5.68%); Volcafe 3.81% (2.85%); Koninklijke Douwe Egberts B.V 3.75% (3.50%) Louis Dreyfus 3.64% (6.06%); Touton SA 3.29% (5.54%) Ecom Agro Industrialst 3.00% (3.79%), Pacorini Silocaf SRL 2.29% (1.37%) and ETG Commodities 2.25% (2.88%); The figures in brackets represent percentage marketshare held in July 2025

Figure 4: Percentage share of Uganda's coffee imported by continent

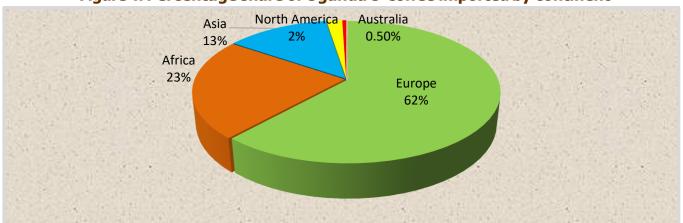
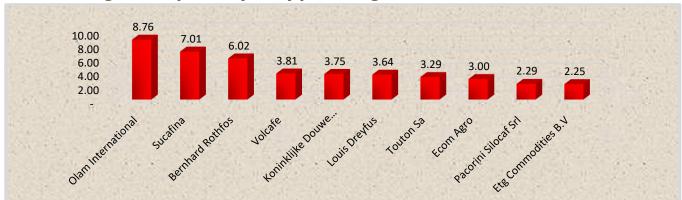


Figure 5: Top ten buyers by percentage market share



6. Global Situation

World coffee production for 2025/26 is forecast to be 4.3 million bags higher than the previous year to a record 178.7 million due to continued recovery in Vietnam and Indonesia as well as record output in Ethiopia. World coffee bean exports are forecast 700,000 bags higher to 122.3 million as gains from Vietnam, Ethiopia, and Indonesia more than offset losses from Brazil and Colombia. Global consumption is forecast at 169.4 million bags, while ending inventories are expected to remain tight at 22.8 million bag. (United States Department of Agriculture, Coffee: World Markets and Trade report-June 2025).

7. Local Situation

During the month of August 2025, farm gate prices ranged from UGX 6,000/=-7,000/= per kilogram of Kiboko (Robusta UGX.13,500/=-14,000/= dry cherries); for FAQ (Fair Average Quality); UGX. 14,000-15,000/= Parchment; and UGX 13,500/=- 14,000/= per kilogram for Drugar. Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 6,500/= higher than UGX 5,250/= Robusta FAQ averaged UGX 13,750/= higher than UGX 10,250, Arabica parchment UGX 14,500 per kilogram, higher than UGX 13,750/= per kilogram the previous month Drugar UGX 13,750/= per kilogram lower than UGX 12,500 per kilogram the previous month.

8. Coffee Development Activities

During the month, most coffee regions experienced varied but generally supportive weather conditions, ranging from modest to normal rains in West Nile, Eastern, Elgon, and Central regions, to drier conditions in parts of Western, Kigezi, and Greater Masaka. The rains facilitated timely planting, gap filling, manuring, and establishment of newly distributed coffee seedlings, while in drier belts farmers focused on land preparation, pruning, de-suckering, and routine field maintenance. Regions such as Elgon, Rwenzori, and Mid-North benefited from above-average rainfall that enhanced establishment of new gardens, and CWDr planting.

During the month of August, 145 farmer trainings were conducted across the eleven regions of; West Nile, South Western, Greater Masaka, Elgon, Western, Kigezi, Eastern, Central, Mid North, Rwenzori and Greater Mpigi reaching 4,039 farmers. The beneficiaries included 2,792 men, 1,247 women, 792 youths, 103 PWDs, and 542 elderly farmers. Major emphasis were good agronomic practices, pest and disease management, and climatesmart coffee production, with strong participation across all categories of farmers.

9. Outlook for September 2025

Uganda's Coffee exports are projected to reach 750,000 60-kilo bags in September 2025. The main harvest season in some parts of Central and Eastern Regions has begun. Farmers and traders still have stocks that are being held as they wait for coffee prices to rise.
