




MONTHLY COFFEE REPORT-JANUARY 2026

COFFEE YEAR 2025/26- ISSUE 4

Key Highlights

A total of 569,454 60-kilo bags of coffee valued at US\$ 161.00 million (UGX 573.50 billion) were exported in January 2026 at an average price of US\$ 4.71/kilogram, US cents 26 lower than US\$ 4.97/Kilogram in December 2025, and US cents 3 lower than the US\$ 4.74/kilogram in January 2024. This was an increase of 1.98% and 1.45% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.



Farm-gate prices for Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 6,250/= per kilogram; FAQ UGX **12,500** per kilogram, Arabica parchment UGX **16,500** per kilogram and Drugar UGX **16,500** per kilogram. Bugisu AA had the highest price registered. (US\$ 7.75 per kilogram).

Coffee exports for twelve months (February 2025-January 2026) totaled 8.9 million bags worth US\$ 2.5 billion (UGX 9 Trillion) compared to 6.1 million bags worth US\$ 1.5 billion (UGX 5.4 trillion) in the previous year (February 2025-January 2026). This represents an increase of 44% and 61% in quantity and value respectively.

67% of the total export volume was exported by top 10 exporters with Ugacof leading in terms of market share (14.34%) out of 82 companies which performed during the month compared to 54% in the month of December 2025. (Annex 1)

1. Coffee exports

Coffee exports in January 2026, totaled to 569,454 60-kilo bags worth US\$ 161.00 million (UGX 573.50 billion). This comprised of 447,599 bags of Robusta valued at US\$ 111.04 million (UGX 395.54 billion) and 121,855 bags of Arabica valued at US\$ 49.96 million (UGX 177.96 billion) (see Table 1). This was an increase of 1.98% and 1.45% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year (January 2025). Robusta decreased by 9.10% and 19.17% in quantity and value respectively, while Arabica exports increased by 84.68% and 134.17% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.

Coffee export volumes were higher than the previous year on account of increased coffee production. Coffee prices at the global scene however was lower than last month (December 2025), mainly driven by an improved global supply outlook after Brazil receiving heavy rainfall in the key coffee-growing region. This eased some of the concerns regarding future coffee supply.

Coffee exports for twelve months (February 2025-January 2026) totaled 8.9 million bags worth US\$ 2.5 billion (UGX 8.9 Trillion) compared to 6.1 million bags worth US\$ 1.5 billion (UGX 5.4 trillion) in the previous year (February 2025-January 2026). This represents an increase of 44% and 61% in quantity and value respectively.

2. Exports by Type and Grade

Table 2 shows coffee exports by type, grade and average price realized for each grade during the month of January 2026. The average export price was US\$ 4.71 per kilogram, US also US cents 26 lower than in December 2025 (US \$ 4.97/kilogram). Robusta exports accounted for 77% of total exports, higher than 73% in December 2025. The average Robusta price was US\$ 4.29 per kilogram, lower than US\$ 4.29 per kilogram in December 2025 The highest price was for Washed Robusta sold at US\$ 5.04 per kilogram, followed by Screen 17 sold at US\$ 4.45 per kilogram.

The share of sustainable/washed coffee to total Robusta exports was 0.7% higher than 0.1% in December 2025. Arabica fetched an average price of US\$ 6.83 per kilogram US cent 1 higher than the previous month (US\$ 6.82). The highest price was for Bugisu AA sold at US\$ 7.75 per kilogram. It was followed by Wugar sold at US\$ 7.48 per kilogram. Drugar was sold at US\$ 6.68 per kilogram, 8 cents higher than US\$ 7.13 per kilogram the previous month, and was 3.6% of total Arabica exports lower than 27% the previous month. The share of sustainable Arabica exports to total Arabica exports was 7%, higher than 5% in December 2025.



3. Individual Exporter Performance

Figure 2 shows the top 10 export companies' performance in the month of January 2026. Ugacof (U) Ltd had the highest market share of 14.34% compared to highest of 9.40% in December 2025. It was followed by Jber coffee Ltd 7.90% (4.19%), Kyagalanyi coffee Ltd 7.72% (5.79%), Export Trading company (U) Ltd 7.55% (6.25%), Olam Uganda Ltd 6.34% (3.72%), Ideal Quality Commodities Ltd 6.28% (7.13%), Louis Dreyfus Company Ltd 5.07% (1.65%), Touton Uganda Limited 4.44% (3.49%), JKCC General Supplies Ltd 3.66% (4.01%) and Kawacom (U) Ltd 3.60% (5.21%) *The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in December 2025. The top 10 exporters held a market share of 67% higher than 54% the previous month reflecting competition at exporter level. Out of the 82 exporters who exported, 27 exported both Robusta and Arabica coffee, 35 exported Robusta Coffee only while 20 exported Arabica coffee only. 4. Coffee Exports By Destination

The destinations of Uganda's coffee exports during the month of January 2026 are shown in **Fig 3** (details in **Annex 2**). Italy remained with the highest market share 26.02% compared to 24.24% last month. It was followed by Germany 10.446% (8.93%), Sudan 9.80% (5.36%), India 6.53% (5.72%) and Belgium 6.15% (11.46%). **The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in December 2025.* The first 10 major destinations of Uganda coffee took a market share of 80% compared to 78% the previous month. Coffee exports to African countries totaled 97,273 bags, a market share of 17% compared to 79,079 bags (16%) the previous month. African countries that imported Uganda coffee included; Sudan, Morocco, Algeria, Egypt, South Africa, Madagascar and Nigeria. Europe remained the main destination for Uganda's coffees with a 63% import share, higher than December 62% in 2025.

5. Foreign buyers of Uganda Coffee

Annex 4 shows a list of Uganda coffee foreign buyers in January 2026. The top 10 buyers held a market share of 51.15% higher than 44.98% the previous month. Sucafina led with a market share of 14.03% compared to 9.21% in December 2025. It was followed by Olam International with 6.34% (3.92%), Volcafe 5.99% (4.80%), Louis Dreyfus 5.07%(2.77%), Touton SA 4.61% (3.48%), Ecom Agro 4.38% (5.47%), Koninklijke Douwe Egberts 3.10% (2.64%), Bernhard rothfos 3.09%(4.44%), Eurocaf SRL 2.40% (1.99%) and Altasheel 2.15%. *The figures in brackets represent percentage marketshare held in December 2025.*

Figure 4: Percentage share of Uganda's coffee imported by continent





Figure 5: Top ten buyers by percentage market share



6. Global Situation

World coffee production for 2025/26 is forecast 3.5 million bags higher than the previous year to reach a record 178.8 million due to continued recovery in Vietnam and record output in Indonesia and Ethiopia, more than compensating for losses in Brazil and Colombia. World coffee bean exports are forecast 2.3 million bags higher to 123.8 million as gains from Vietnam, Indonesia, and Honduras more than offset losses from Brazil and Colombia. With global consumption continuing to rise to a record 173.9 million bags, ending stocks are expected to drop for a fifth-consecutive year to just 20.1 million bags. In response, coffee prices as measured by the International Coffee Organization (ICO) monthly composite price index have nearly tripled during this period. (United States Department of Agriculture, Coffee: World Markets and Trade report-December 2025).

7. Local Situation

During the month of January 2026, farm gate prices ranged from UGX 6,000-6,500 per kilogram of Kiboko (Robusta dry cherries); UGX 12,000-13,000 for FAQ (Fair Average Quality); UGX 16,000-17,000 for Arabica Parchment; and UGX 16,000-17,000 per kilogram for Drugar. Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 6,250 per kilogram lower than UGX 6,750 per kilogram previous month, Robusta FAQ averaged UGX 12,500 lower than UGX 13,500 per kilogram, Arabica parchment UGX 16,500 per kilogram, lower than UGX 16,750 per kilogram the previous month. Drugar UGX 16,500 per kilogram the same as the previous month.

8. Coffee Development Activities

During the month, extensive efforts were undertaken to strengthen coffee production, productivity and improve coffee quality across the country. A total of 114 coffee farmer trainings were conducted nationwide, reaching 3,306 farmers, including 2,476 men, 830 women, 597 youth, 36 PWDs and 330 elderly farmers, reflecting a commitment to inclusive sector development. The trainings focused on coffee establishment and farm management, covering critical practices such as proper planting and spacing, selection of quality planting materials, shade management, intercropping, and management of newly planted coffee. Farmers were also guided on recommended post-harvest handling practices, aimed at enhancing coffee quality and market competitiveness.

To reinforce on-farm support, 196 farm visits and inspections were conducted across the country, reaching to 890 farmers. These engagements enabled the identification of key production challenges, notably the continued prevalence of pests and diseases. In response, farmers received targeted technical guidance on pest and disease management, water stress mitigation, as well as weeding, pruning, stumping, and the adoption of climate-smart agricultural practices.

Rehabilitation of aging coffee gardens remained a priority during the month, with 233,350 coffee trees stumped by 2141 farmers, including 1581 men and 560 women, to restore productivity in old and unproductive plantations. In support of improved yields and soil health, 5973 bags of fertilizer were distributed to 1278 farmers.

Quality assurance and regulatory oversight were also strengthened through inspections of 145 hullers, 131 buying stores, 10 grading facilities, 11 roasters and 2 wash stations, alongside the installation of 9 new wash stations and factories. Additionally, 25 post-harvest handling and Good Manufacturing Practices(GMP) training sessions were conducted in Rwenzori, Northern, and Kigezi, reaching 283 participants.

Licensing and enforcement activities during the period covered 144 hullers, 120 buying stores, 6 roasters, and 5 grading facility. Quality assurance efforts included the collection of 30 coffee samples for laboratory analysis and support to 19 traders and processors through direct engagements

9. Outlook for February 2026

Uganda's Coffee exports are projected to reach 500,000 60-kilo bags in February 2026. The main harvest season in parts of Central and Eastern Regions has ended.
