



MONTHLY COFFEE REPORT-FEBRUARY 2026

COFFEE YEAR 2025/26- ISSUE 5

Key Highlights

A total of 651,933 60-kilo bags of coffee valued at US\$ 180.98 million (UGX 573.50 billion) were exported in February 2026 at an average price of US\$ 4.63/kilogram, US cents 8 lower than US\$ 4.71/Kilogram in January 2026, and US cents 40 lower than the US\$ 5.03/kilogram in February 2025. This was an increase of 14.93% and 5.75% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.



Coffee exports for twelve months (March 2025-February 2026) totaled 8.8 million bags worth US\$ 2.5 billion (UGX 9 Trillion) compared to 6.3 million bags worth US\$ 1.6 billion (UGX 6 trillion) in the previous year (March 2024- February 2025). This represents an increase of 41% and 61% in quantity and value respectively.

66% of the total export volume was exported by top 10 exporters with Ugacof leading in terms of market share (14.43%) out of 79 companies which performed during the month compared to 67% in the month of January 2026. (Annex 1)

Farm-gate prices for Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 5,750/= per kilogram; FAQ UGX **12,250** per kilogram, Arabica parchment UGX **15,500** per kilogram and Drugar UGX **14,500** per kilogram. Mt. Elgon A+ had the highest price registered. (US\$ 9.99 per kilogram).

1. Coffee exports

Coffee exports in February 2026, totaled to 651,933 60-kilo bags worth US\$ 180.98 million (UGX 645.78 billion). This comprised of 512,237 bags of Robusta valued at US\$ 124.66 million (UGX 444.81 billion) and 139,696 bags of Arabica valued at US\$ 56.32 million (UGX 200.97 billion) (see Table 1). This was an increase of 14.93% and 5.75% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year (January 2025). Robusta increased by 7.51% in quantity and decreased by 9.79% in value while Arabica exports increased by 53.93% and 70.85% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.

Coffee export volumes during the month were higher than February of last year on account of increased coffee production. Coffee prices during the month however declined compared to January 2026 in line with the decline at the global scene due to improved supply outlook including strong production forecasts for Brazil, with expectations of a global supply surplus for coffee year 2025/26.

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Fig 1: Trend of Total Quantity and Value of Coffee Exports, March 2025- February 2026

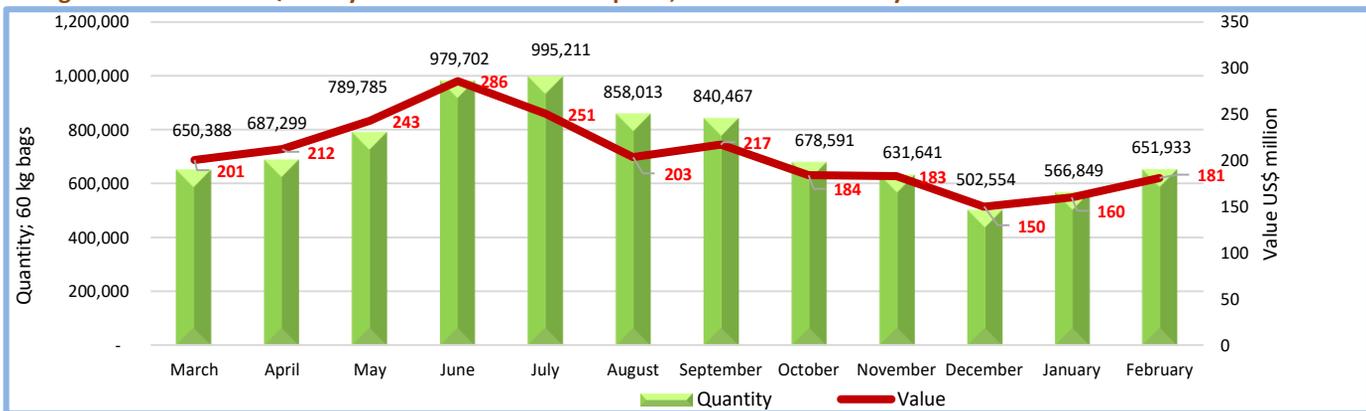

2. Exports by Type and Grade

Table 2 shows coffee exports by type, grade and average price realized for each grade during the month of February 2026. The average export price was US\$ 4.63 per kilogram, US also U S cents 8 lower than in January 2026 (US\$ 4.71/kilogram). Robusta exports accounted for 79% of total exports, higher than 77% in January 2026. The average Robusta price was US\$ 4.06 per kilogram, lower than US\$ 4.13 per kilogram in January 2026 The highest price was for Washed Robusta sold at US\$ 4.87 per kilogram, followed by Screen 18 sold at US\$ 4.35 per kilogram.

The share of Sustainable/washed coffee to total Robusta exports was 0.5% lower than 0.7% in January 2026. Arabica fetched an average price of US\$ 6.72 per kilogram US cents 11 higher than the previous month (US\$ 6.83). The highest price was for Mt. Elgon A+ sold at US\$ 9.99 per kilogram. It was followed by Mt. Elgon AB sold at US\$ 7.70 per kilogram. Drugar was sold at US\$ 6.74 per kilogram, US cents 6 higher than US\$ 6.68 per kilogram the previous month, and was 33% of total Arabica exports lower than 39% the previous month. The share of sustainable Arabica exports to total Arabica exports was 11%, higher than 7% in January 2026.

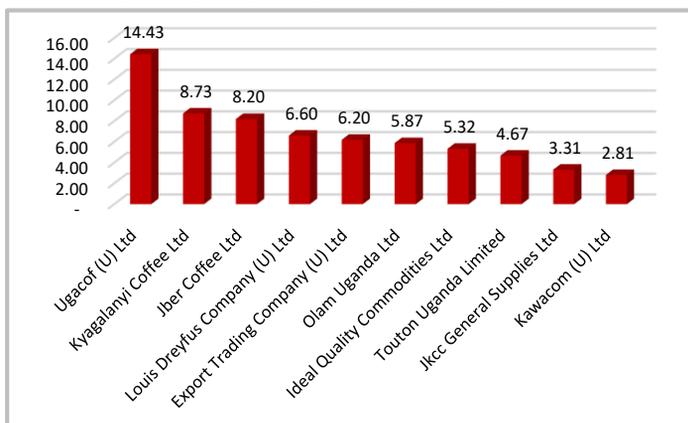

3. Individual Exporter Performance

Figure 2 shows the top 10 export companies' performance in the month of February 2026. Ugacof (U) Ltd had the highest market share of 14.43% compared to highest of 14.34% in January 2026. It was followed by Kyagalanyi coffee Ltd 8.73% (7.72%), Jber coffee Ltd 8.20% (7.90%), Louis Dreyfus Company Ltd 6.60% (5.07%), Export Trading Company (U) Ltd 6.20% (7.55%), Olam Uganda Ltd 5.87% (6.34%), Ideal Quality Commodities 5.32% (6.28%), Touton Uganda Limited 4.67% (4.44%), JKCC General Supplies Ltd 3.31% (3.66%) and Kawacom (U) Ltd 2.81% (3.60%) *The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in January 2026. The top 10 exporters held a market share of 66% lower than 67% the previous month reflecting competition at exporter level. Out of the 79 exporters who exported, 27 exported both Robusta and Arabica coffee, 32 exported Robusta Coffee only while 20 exported Arabica coffee only. 4. Coffee Exports By Destination

The destinations of Uganda's coffee exports during the month of February 2026 are shown in **Fig 3** (details in **Annex 2**). Italy remained with the highest market share 28.80% compared to 26.02% last month. It was followed by Sudan 9.95% (9.80%), Germany 8.41% (10.44%), India 7.95% (6.53%) and Morocco 7.26% (3.14%). **The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in January 2026.* The first 10 major destinations of Uganda coffee took a market share of 79% compared to 80% the previous month. Coffee exports to African countries totaled 140,694 bags, a market share of 22% compared to 97,273 bags (17%) the previous month. African countries that imported Uganda coffee included; Sudan, Morocco, Algeria, Egypt, South Africa and Kenya. Europe remained the main destination for Uganda's coffees with a 58% import share, lower than 63% in January 2026.

5. Foreign buyers of Uganda Coffee

Annex 4 shows a list of Uganda coffee foreign buyers in February 2026. The top 10 buyers held a market share of 52.67% higher than 51.15% the previous month. Sucafina led with a market share of 15.00% compared to 14.03% in January 2026. It was followed by Olam International with 7.14% (6.34%), Louis Dreyfus 6.85% (5.07%), Volcafe 6.35%(5.99%), Touton SA 4.67% (4.61%), Ecom Agroindustrialist 3.17% (4.38%), Bernhard Rothfos 2.90% (3.09%), ETG Commodities B.V 2.38% (3.09%), Aldwami 2.15% (0.61%) and Altasheel Import & Export enterprises 2.06%(2.15%). *The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in January 2026.*

Figure 4: Percentage share of Uganda's coffee imported by continent

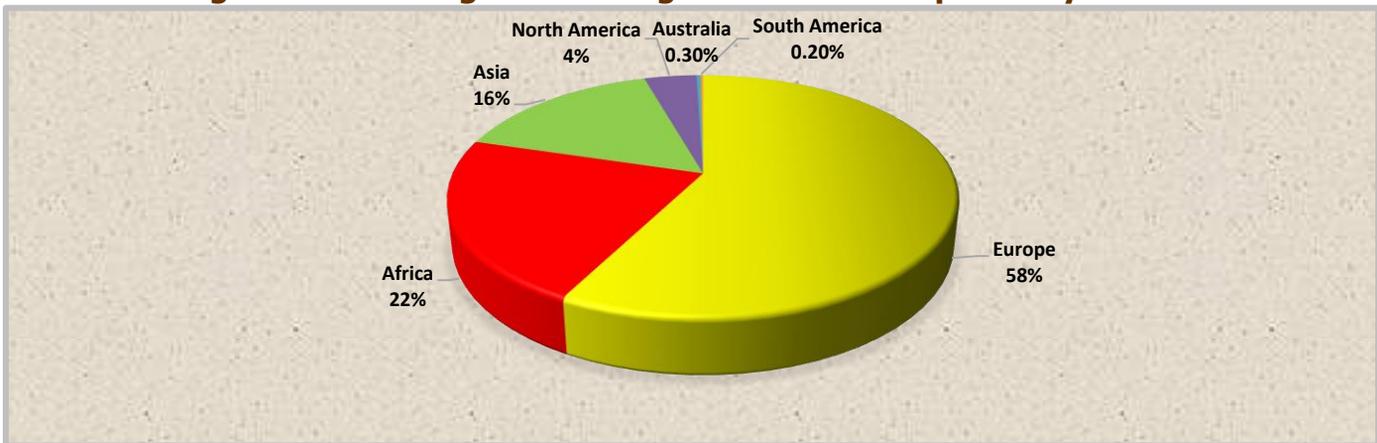
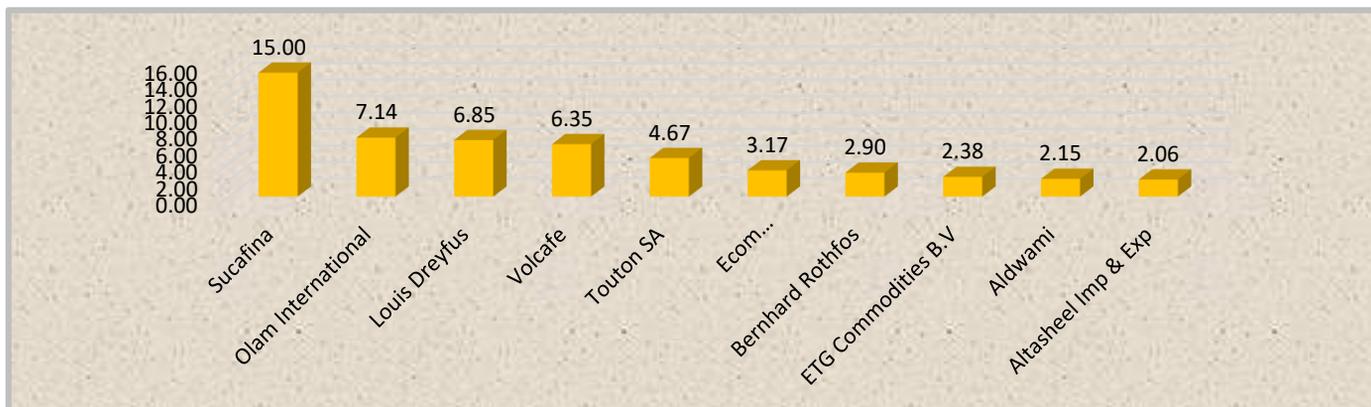


Figure 5: Top ten buyers by percentage market share



6. Global Situation

World coffee production for 2025/26 is forecast 3.5 million bags higher than the previous year to reach a record 178.8 million due to continued recovery in Vietnam and record output in Indonesia and Ethiopia, more than compensating for losses in Brazil and Colombia. World coffee bean exports are forecast 2.3 million bags higher to 123.8 million as gains from Vietnam, Indonesia, and Honduras more than offset losses from Brazil and Colombia. With global consumption continuing to rise to a record 173.9 million bags, ending stocks are expected to drop for a fifth-consecutive year to just 20.1 million bags. In response, coffee prices as measured by the International Coffee Organization (ICO) monthly composite price index have nearly tripled during this period. (United States Department of Agriculture, Coffee: World Markets and Trade report-December 2025).

7. Local Situation

During the month of January 2026, farm gate prices ranged from UGX 5,500-6,000 per kilogram of Kiboko (Robusta dry cherries); UGX 12,000-12,500 for FAQ (Fair Average Quality); UGX 15,000-16,000 for Arabica Parchment; and UGX 14,000-15,000 per kilogram for Drugar. Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 5,750 per kilogram lower than UGX 6,250 per kilogram previous month, Robusta FAQ averaged UGX 12,250 lower than UGX 12,500 per kilogram, Arabica parchment UGX 15,500 per kilogram, lower than UGX 16,500 per kilogram the previous month. Drugar UGX 14,500 per kilogram lower than 16,500/= per kilogram the previous month.

8. Coffee Development Activities

During the month of February, a total of 155 farmer trainings were conducted, reaching 4,680 farmers (3,272 men, 1,408 women), including 879 youth, 103 persons with disabilities, and 288 elderly farmers. Trainings focused on Good Agricultural Practices (GAPs), climate-smart coffee production, stumping, shade management, Coffee Wilt Disease control, safe pesticide use, pest and disease management, post-harvest handling, quality assurance, and EUDR compliance.

To reinforce learning at farm level, 215 field visits were conducted, reaching 896 farmers (710 men, 186 women), including 90 youth, 5 PWDs, and 105 elderly. These engagements provided hands-on advisory support to improve farm management practices.

In order to enhance soil productivity, 99 soil samples from 76 farmers across six regions were collected and analysed. Results showed that low organic matter, and in some cases nitrogen deficiency, were key constraints. Farmers were guided on integrated soil fertility management practices to improve soil health and yields.

Eleven (11) radio talk shows across multiple regions were conducted, and knowledge dissemination on land preparation, climate-smart practices, pest and disease control, post-harvest handling, and EUDR compliance, thereby extending technical guidance to a wider farming audience.

Under the Uganda Climate Smart Agriculture Transformation Project (UCSATP), 3 Training-of-Trainers sessions were held in Mbale, Kampala, and Iganga, equipping 232 district local government officials (177 men, 55 women) with skills in climate-smart agriculture, value chain development, pest management, and monitoring & evaluation to support scaling of best practices.

Six hundred sixteen (616) stakeholders—including local governments, processors, development partners, and faith-based institutions were engaged to strengthen coordination and support coffee sector initiatives. Notably, partnerships with Catholic dioceses in the Rwenzori region are promoting coffee planting on church land.

Quality assurance and compliance efforts, with inspections were conducted on 130 hullers, 72 buying stores, 16 traders, and 2 wash stations. This led to the licensing of 43 hullers, 73 buying stores, and 1 wash station, reinforcing adherence to national standards and improving coffee quality across the value chain.

9. Outlook for March 2026

Uganda's Coffee exports are projected to reach 650,000 60- kilo bags in March 2026. The main harvest season in Greater Masaka and South Western region will peak in April-May.
